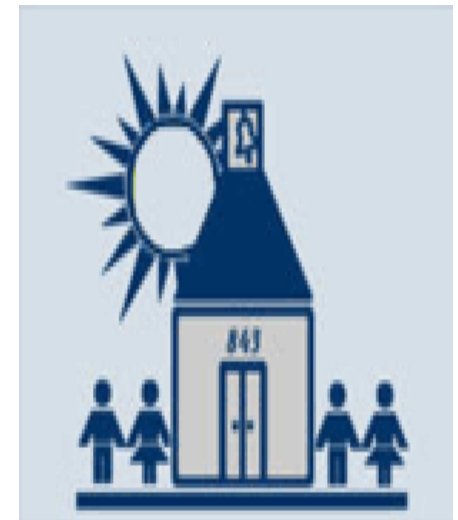

How it Works

Your family will go through a 6-week long consultation process that will assist you with academic, social, or behavioral issues happening at home.

A behavior interventionist will work with your family to create and monitor an intervention specific to your concern.

Consultations are aimed (but do not need) to include an educator to develop an intervention across school and home.

Weekly meetings with you, the behavior interventionist, and your child's teacher will happen at a convenient location and time.

How to Participate

- Determine how to best include your child's teacher in the consultation process
- Obtain and complete a referral form
- Submit form to the front office
- The behavior interventionist will contact you to begin the process

5 Step Consultation Process

- Intake Interview
- Conjoint Problem Identification Interview
- Conjoint Problem Analysis Interview
- Plan Implementation
- Conjoint Plan Evaluation Interview
