

RESOLUTION #16-02
PREVAILING WAGE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, codified as amended, 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq. (1933), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 48, par. 39s-1 et seq. and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Lincoln-Way Area Special Education Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of Will County, Illinois, employed in performing construction of public works for said Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF SPECIAL EDUCATION OF LINCOLN-WAY AREA SPECIAL EDUCATION, JOINT AGREEMENT DISTRICT 843, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Will County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The Lincoln-Way Area Special Education Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.


SECTION 4: The Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Lincoln-Way Area Special Education, Joint Agreement District 843, Will County, Illinois, Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Will County Regional Office of Education shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.






